History and present of the department

- The Department of Economic Geography of the Faculty of Geology and Geography of the University of Kharkiv was founded in 1934.
- In 2002 it was named as the Department of "Human Geography and Regional Studies".
- The department is headed by Doctor of Geographical Sciences,
 Professor Liudmya Niemets.
- 5 doctors of sciences, professors, 10 associate professors provide students professional training using modern techniques and the latest teaching technologies.
- There is a teaching laboratory of the Faculty of Geology, Geography, Recreation and Tourism, which provides educational process of the lecturers of the department, where students enable to use computers and the Internet.
- The library fund of the department has more than **750 copies**, which are used by students in preparing for the classes.
- Today 104 students study at the department, including 2 foreigners and 3 PhD students.






International Cooperation of the department


