Participants should submit:

• Application form for each participant where it's needed to indicate:

- 1. First and last names.
- 2. Position, academic degree, academic title.
- 3. Institution (HEI, faculty, department; research institute etc.), its post address.
- 4. Country, city.
- 5. Postal address (for sending a proceedings, if you are a correspondent participant), contact telephone, fax, e-mail
- 6. Necessity to send a conference proceedings by mail (in case of part-time participation).
- 7. Scientific area of the conference.
- 8. Name of the report
- 9. Scientific supervisor (for students and PhD students)
- 10. If any presentation equipment is needed.
- 11. Form of participation in the conference (full-time or part-time).
- 12. Advance booking for accommodation.
- **Paper** via <u>e-mail</u> with confirmation of receiving by the organizational committee. The file format is *.doc. (*.docx). The name of the file last name of the author (e.g. **Petrenko.doc)**.

Requirements for the papers: up to 5 pages; Microsoft Word for Windows; page A4, portrait orientation; margins 2 cm; Times New Roman, 14 pt; Line spacing 1.5; Paragraph indention 1 cm. Manuscripts must not be published before our currently are not being submitted in other editions.

The article should include: the title of the report in capital letters in bold type, centered; through the line – first and last name of the author (-s) in a bold italic type, centered; on the next line – e-mail of author (-s), italic type, centered. On the next line – the full name of the institution, italic type. Through the line from an indent the abstract is placed, below – key words. Abstract and key words are given in English. Through the line from an indent the text of the paper is placed. References are given in square brackets [1]. Under the text (through the line) the list of references (in APA style) in italic type, 12 pt is given.

Don't put difficult graphic material and big tables in the text.

The articles are accepted if they correspond to subjects of the conference and indicated requirements, reviewed. Students can be published only in co-authorship with the supervisor. Materials of the conference will be published by the beginning of the conference. The conference proceeding will be published in author's edition.
