Deadline for submitting manuscripts is **October 10, 2021**.

Participants should submit:

## • Application form for each participant where it's needed to indicate:

- 1. First and last names.
- 2. Position, academic degree, academic title.
- 3. Institution (HEI, faculty, department; research institute etc.), its post address.
- 4. Country, city.
- 5. Postal address, contact telephone, fax, e-mail
- 6. Necessity to send a conference proceeding by mail.
- 7. Scientific area of the conference.
- 8. Name of the report.
- 9. Scientific supervisor (for students and PhD students).
- 10. If any presentation equipment is needed.
- 11. Form of participation in the conference (full-time, online or part-time).
- **Manuscript** via <u>e-mail</u> with confirmation of receiving by the organizational committee. The file format is \*.doc. (\*.docx). The name of the file last name of the author (e.g. **Petrenko.doc)**.

**Requirements for the papers:** up to 3 pages; Microsoft Word for Windows; page A4, portrait orientation; margins 2 cm; Times New Roman, 14 pt; Line spacing 1.5; Paragraph indention 1 cm.

Manuscripts must not be published before or currently are not being submitted in other editions.

The manuscript should include: the title of the report in capital letters in bold type, centered; first and last name of the author (-s) in a bold italic type, centered are placed through the line; e-mail of author (-s), italic type, centered is given on the next line. The full name of the institution, italic type is placed on the next line. The abstract is given through the line from an indent, key words are placed below. Abstract and key words are placed in English. The text of the paper is given through the line from an indent. References are given in square brackets [1]. The list of references (in APA style) in italic type, 12 pt is provided under the text (through the line).

Don't put difficult graphic material and big tables in the text.

The manuscripts are accepted if they correspond to subjects of the conference and indicated requirements, they have been reviewed. Students can be published only in coauthorship with the supervisor. Materials of the conference are going to be published by the beginning of the conference. The conference proceeding will be published in author's edition.
