Official languages of the conference: Ukrainian, English.

Deadline for submission papers: November 10, 2025.

Scientific areas of the conference:

- 1. Economic transformations of regional development.
- 2. Demographic, migration and social challenges of regional development.
- 3. Environmental problems of regional development.
- 4. Urban development, geoplanning and urban politics.

Participants should submit via *e-mail*:

- Application form for each participant where it's needed to indicate:
 - 1. First and last names.
 - 2. Position, academic degree, academic title.
 - 3. Institution (HEI, faculty, department; research institute etc.), its post address.
 - 4. Country, city.
 - 5. Contact phone, fax, e-mail.
 - 6. Scientific area of the conference.
 - 7. Name of the report.
 - 8. Scientific supervisor (for students and PhD students). The name of the file e.g. **Petrenko_zayavka.docx**).
- **Paper** with confirmation of receiving by the organizational committee. The file format is *.doc. (*.docx). The name of the file last name of the author (e.g. **Petrenko.docx**).

Requirements for the papers: up to 4 pages; Microsoft Word for Windows; page A4, portrait orientation; margins 2 cm; Times New Roman, 14 pt; line spacing 1.5; Paragraph indention 1 cm.

Manuscripts must not be published before or currently are not being submitted in other editions.

The paper should include: Universal decimal classification number (UDC); through the line – the title of the report in capital letters in bold type, centered; through the line – first and last name of the author (-s) in a bold italic type, centered; on the next line – e-mail of author (-s), italic type, centered. On the next line – the full name of the institution, italic type. Through the line from an indent the text of the paper is placed. References to sources used should be given in square brackets [1]. Under the text (through the line) the list of references (in APA style) in italic type, 12 pt is given.

Don't put difficult graphic material and big tables in the text.

The articles are accepted if they correspond to subjects of the conference and indicated requirements, reviewed. Students can be published only in co-authorship with the supervisor. The conference proceeding will be published in author's edition.
